1    **REMEDIAL INSTRUCTION**

2    The remedial program will concentrate mainly on improvement of reading and math skills for the most  
 3    educationally needy students. ~~Various materials will be used to supplement the work being done in the~~  
 4    ~~classroom.~~

5    **HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION**

6    The Homebound Instruction Program is for students who, ~~because of medical conditions,~~ because of  
 7    **illness or injury** are unable to attend the regular instructional program.<sup>1</sup>

8    To qualify for the Homebound Program, a student must have ~~a health impairment~~ **an illness or injury**  
 9    of sufficient seriousness **as** to anticipate that the student will be absent for a minimum of ~~ten (10)~~ **five**  
 10    **(5)** consecutive school days. The student must be certified by a physician as ~~having a medical~~  
 11    ~~condition~~ **health impaired** and unable to attend the regular instructional program. The services  
 12    provided the homebound student should reflect capabilities and be determined by the homebound  
 13    instructor, after consultation with appropriate ~~health services~~ staff of the student's assigned school.

14    **HOMEBOUND PROGRAM FOR PREGNANT STUDENTS** <sup>1,2</sup>

15    The homebound instruction program for pregnant students shall consist of three (3) hours of instruction  
 16    per week for a period of six (6) weeks.<sup>2</sup> The student's physician shall recommend, in writing, the (6)  
 17    six week period for which the student shall be eligible for homebound instruction.

18    A homebound instruction program for longer than the six (6) week period shall only be provided to a  
 19    student who is certified in writing by her physician as having health complications arising from the  
 20    pregnancy that prevent her from returning to regular classes.
